

Anonymous tip results in suspect's arrest.

The Luzerne County Sheriff's Department arrested Wilkes-Barre resident Lenard Alexis Aro, 25, on Saturday on outstanding arrest warrants stemming from felony drug charges.

The department was following up on a call to its anonymous tip line in which the caller said they had just been at Sam's Club in Wilkes-Barre Township and Aro had changed their tires, Sheriff Michael Savokinas said.

Aro was taken to the Luzerne County Correctional Facility.

Aro's apprehension was the third arrest made as a result of calls to the anonymous tip line, Savokinas said.
