1. Earth Conservancy Reclamation and Recreation Road Project serving Hanover Township, Sugar Notch Borough, and Warrior Run Borough.
2. Fairmont Township Completion of Road Reconstruction project.
3. Conyngham Township Recreational Park North for park improvements.
4. Municipality of Kingston Hoyt Library for improvements to the library.
5. Wilkes-Barre Township ADA Improvements for Recreational Facility at Meadow Run Road Camp in Thornhurst.
6. Ruth's Place Emergency Women's Shelter in Wilkes-Barre for move-in renovations to the women's homeless shelter.
7. Ross Township Street for Niemchik Road Reconstruction Project.
8. Swoyersville Borough Hughes Street Road Reconstruction project.
9. Newport Township (Glen Lyon) Demolition of 4 dilapidated structures.
10. Forty Fort Borough for ADA improvements to the Forty Fort pool.
11. Plains Township for demolition of 3 derelict structures.
12. Kind/Edward NRSA for the community revitalization project in Kingston and Edwardsville.
