

Part Time Driver
Luzerne/Wyoming Counties Transportation Department

L/WCTD provides para-transit service to the elderly, children and youth services, and special needs persons throughout Luzerne and Wyoming Counties. Transportation is provided on the department's wheelchair accessible vans and mini buses.

Part-time drivers supplement the full-time staff on an as needed basis and might be scheduled 2 to 5 days per week depending upon availability. Most workdays are full day shifts and can start between 6:30 -8:30 a.m. and end between 3:30-6:30 p.m.

Hourly wage for part-time drivers currently starts at \$8.00/hour and increases by \$.25 every 6 months or 600 hours worked (which ever occurs first) up to \$9.00/hour.

Applicants must be high school graduates, have a current driver's license with a clean driving record, and be of high moral character with no criminal history and possess the ability to work on their own following detailed written and oral instructions. All applicants must agree to, and pass, a thorough background check and Dept. of Transportation physical examination.

Applicants will be dealing with the general public, as well as community based service agencies, and must always deport themselves in a friendly and courteous manner. Additionally, effective working relationships must be maintained with other employees of the department.

New drivers will receive 8 hours of classroom instruction and preparation and no less than 2 days of on-the-road training with an experienced driver/trainer, before a decision will be made as to readiness to begin on his own.
