

Widow's Burial Instructions

1. A Deceased Serviceman's Widow is defined as the unremarried widow of any soldier, sailor, airman or marine who has served with the combative forces of the United States during any war or campaign in which the United States has been engaged and who has been honorably discharged from such periods of service, according to the records of the War or Navy Departments.
2. Application shall be made by personal representative or next of kin of the widow, individual or any veterans organization who or which assumes responsibility for the burial of the widow.
3. Application must be made within a year from the date of death. Total expenses of burial shall not exceed \$1,000.00. No application will be given consideration unless fully completed.
4. Certified copy of the public record of death must be attached to this application, as well as itemized statement from the undertaker of the expenses incurred in the burial. (Proof of marriage and widowhood will be disclosed by the death certificate.)
5. Affidavits are required by the application and the undertaker as to the facts stated in the application.
