4 Wanted Fugitives Arrested

On Tuesday night, February 5, 2008 Sheriff Michael A. Savokinas announces the following arrests were made by the Luzerne County Sheriff's Department Special Investigation Division and Local Police. The following were arrested by the Luzerne County Special Investigation Division, Melissa GERAGHTY (20) of Wilkes-Barre at her residence on outstanding charges of 2 counts Theft by Unlawful Taking and Receiving Stolen Property. Joseph David JACKIEL (62) of Wilkes-Barre was arrested on Lee Park Ave Hanover Twp on outstanding charges of Terroristic Threats and Harassment. Kenneth LAMOREAUX (41) of Shickshinny was taken into custody on a traffic stop by Swoyersville Police and was found to be entered into N.C.I.C as a wanted fugitive for Fleeing or Attempting to Elude Police, Resisting arrest, D.U.I and Disorderly Conduct. Swoyersville Police then contacted Sheriff's Special Investigation Division who then took custody of the subject. Deborah WALLACE (52) of Duryea was taken into custody by Avoca and Duryea Police Departments and was found to be a wanted fugitive on outstanding charges of Simple Assault, Disorderly Conduct and Harassment. Authorities then contacted Sheriff's Department Special Investigation Division who then took custody of the subject. All individuals were lodged at the Luzerne County Correctional Facility awaiting hearings.
