

Alleged fugitive captured in Hanover Township

HANOVER TWP. - An alleged fugitive from New York is being held at the Luzerne County Correctional Facility for lack of \$500,000 after his capture in Hanover Township Wednesday night, according to arrest and court records.

Jeremiha Hamilton, 23, also known as Havoc Brown and Kellen S. Brown, was captured at a Mark Drive residence in the Marion Terrace Apartment complex by township police and the Luzerne County Sheriff's Department at about 8:20 p.m.

Hamilton was wanted in New York on an alleged violation of probation for an unspecified drug conviction, arrest records say.

He was arraigned early Thursday morning by District Judge Joseph Halsey in Hanover Township with being a fugitive from justice. An extradition hearing will be scheduled in the Luzerne County Court of Common Pleas at a later date.
