Dear Council members,

Please work to find out when weeds will be trimmed on roads such as Blytheburn. Mr. Plesh continues to give our committee, Fix Our Roads Luzerne County, inaccurate work schedules and promises that never transpire, week after week.

We understand there is only a crew of nine in Road and Bridge. This is for the whole county.

Please request that Road and Bridge either outsource entirely or major funding, manpower and resources be immediately addressed. This has become a serious emergency. Safety and liability should never be risked by our county.

On behalf of FORLC, we respectfully ask that no Road and Bridge worker be asked or assigned to work a concert venue, perform landscaping duties for county-owned buildings and properties, clean up along the river or move office furniture for any department of our county government.

FORLC also asks that all work needed be amply advertised, including outside our county, for all interested parties to bid on and any maintenance or road work be assigned purchase orders for transparency and tracking.
