Dear Madam Chair, Vice-Chair and members of Council,

There are numerous reports of a 50+ million-dollar loan being considered for one or two bridges. This loan would be primarily funded from the changed law in 2020 that gives the first three-million dollars from the locally shared account to our county before monetary awards are given based on applications.

With over 120 miles of county-owned roads and a statement by our then acting county manager in 2021 that it would take 50 million dollars to properly repair them, I am asking that our council members refuse to secure one loan for one community for one or two bridges when every resident can benefit from securing the same loan for all of our roads county-wide.
