

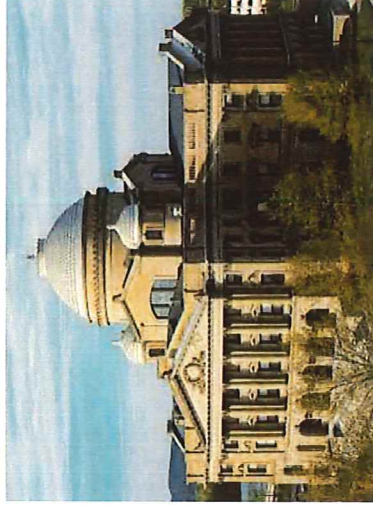

Proclamation



WHEREAS, The Miners Mills Triangle Club is celebrating the momentous occasion of its seventy-fifth anniversary; and

WHEREAS, in January 1945, 32 citizens of Miners Mills, applied for a charter to start a social club. They called it the Miners Mills Triangle Club. The purpose of the club was to provide recreation for its members and for the helpful and moral uplift of the citizenry, and also to provide home or club rooms for its members. In February 1945, they were granted a charter at 24 East Main Street. By 1948 they had moved to 52 East Main Street and were issued a liquor license. By 1958 they had moved to their present address at 77 East Main Street; and

WHEREAS, for the past 75 years, their motto has been “always for the kids”. Every year they had free Easter, Halloween and Christmas parties for the area children. They have supported area children’s sports teams financially and with donated labor. They provided meeting rooms for both the boy scouts and the girl scouts. They have hosted numerous fund raisers for sick or injured children in the area.

NOW THEREFORE, WE, the Luzerne County Council, do hereby proclaim its gratitude and honor for all the members of the Miners Mills Triangle Club who embody civic duty and community pride for all residents of Luzerne County on their seventy-fifth anniversary.
