

**RESOLUTION R-2018-72
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

*A Resolution of the Luzerne County Council Authorizing the County Manager
to Execute a Five-Year No-Cost License Agreement for Non-Federal Use of Real Property with the
Department of Veterans Affairs*

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council has authority to approve of all leases concerning real property; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Veterans Affairs owns and operates the Wilkes-Barre VA Medical Center located on East End Boulevard in Plains Township, Luzerne County; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County 9-1-1 has utilized this site for communications for over 15 years and seeks to continue using this important communications site for radio coverage in Luzerne County; and

WHEREAS, Phase I of the countywide radio system needs assessment identified the necessity to extensively overhaul the VA Medical Center site in order to ensure continuing radio coverage; and

WHEREAS, the subject 5-year no-cost license will permit Luzerne County the opportunity to make the necessary repairs to the site to maintain the radio equipment, thereby protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Council authorizes the County Manager to execute the attached Revocable License for Non-Federal Use of Real Property.

This Resolution shall become effective 6 days after adoption.


