A Resolution by the Luzerne County Council Requesting a Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant from the Pennsylvania Commonwealth Financing Authority

WHEREAS, Luzerne County has become aware of available grant funding to be used for improvements to certain roads; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County believes it is in its best interests to request a Multimodal Transportation Fund grant of \$150,000 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for a traffic study and the installation of bus bump-outs along New Commerce Boulevard in the Hanover Industrial Estates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Council does approve the submission of an application for a Multimodal Transportation Fund grant of \$150,000 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for a traffic study and the installation of bus bump-outs along New Commerce Boulevard in the Hanover Industrial Estates.



This resolution shall become effective immediately.




