

**Luzerne County, Pennsylvania Engineering and Surveying Services Project
RFP – Questions and Answers #1**

Dear Proposer,

Listed below are the answers to the questions received as of 4:00 P.M. EST, May August 6, 2019.

Question 1: Is there a preferred access route the location for the Tower?

Answer 1: There is no current road in place to the proposed Tower Site area – although there is an ATV/Snowmobile trail that the landlord would like used for the tower site road. The road will have to be built when the tower is approved for construction.

Question 2: If a new access will need to be designed and constructed are there any restrictions from the landowner for the location of the road?

Answer 2: Yes. Landowner has asked for the most direct route to the tower site, preferably the current ATV/Snowmobile trail; the only restriction was that the Fish Commission wanted first right of refusal for any trees removed for tower road or site construction. Selected vendor will decide best path and mark trees to be removed. The only other note is that we have to have a route that does not encroach on neighboring parcels.

Question 3: Is there an existing access available for a drilling rig to reach the top for the purpose of geotechnical investigations?

Answer 3: There is a narrow snowmobile trail that could be used by a “tracked” drilling vehicle. Vendors are welcome to contact the county to schedule a site visit to see the site and trail.

Question 4: Can you confirm the coordinates for the Harris Pond tower site?

Answer 4: Yes, -76.129 is the longitude, and 41.303 is the latitude.
