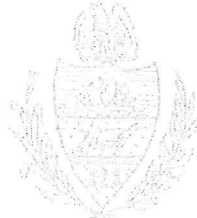

The following information is being requested pursuant to Pennsylvania's Right-to-Know Law, 65 P.S. §67.101 *et seq.* This request seeks information relating to women incarcerated within your county jail or prison. Please provide the following information:

- 1) In General- This section is limited to the policies and procedures in place since July 1, 2017
 - a) All policies and procedures that relate to providing medical care for pregnant women, including any documents that reference abortion care;
 - b) All policies, procedures, and documents regarding the use, provision, or availability of menstruation products, including any relevant commissary lists;
 - c) All policies, procedures, and documents that relate to the use of restraints during pregnancy;
 - d) All policies, procedures, and documents regarding the use of medication to treat pregnant people with opioid addiction (Medication Assisted Treatment), including:
 - i) criteria to qualify for medication to help with opioid addiction,
 - ii) guidelines for distributing opioid addiction treatment drugs,
 - iii) medication people are given to treat their opioid addiction,
(1) e.g., Buprenorphine, Naloxone, Suboxone, Methadone, Vivitrol,
 - iv) duration of treatment,
 - v) frequency of treatment,
 - vi) continuation of treatment after pregnancy ends.

- 2) Statistics-This section seeks information from July 1, 2014 until present. If available, please provide this information on a monthly basis.
 - a) Records of the total number of:
 - i) pregnant people,
 - ii) pregnant people transported to a provider for abortion care,
 - iii) miscarriages
 - iv) people who carry their child(ren) to term while incarcerated,
 - v) births within the correctional institution (not taken to hospital or care provider);
 - b) Records reflecting how often restraints are used on pregnant women people;
 - c) Records reflecting how often materials are distributed or made available to people concerning the prison's reproductive healthcare and pregnancy policies,;
 - d) Records of how often materials are distributed concerning:
 - i) access to pads and tampons,
 - ii) general reproductive policies,
 - iii) access to opioid addiction treatment;

- 3) Documentation
 - a) Commissary list of those products available for incarcerated people to purchase, including but not limited to feminine hygiene products;
 - b) Any informational materials relating to reproductive healthcare, abortions, or parenting in prison that are provided to incarcerated people;
 - c) the Jail's prisoner/inmate handbook provided to those incarcerated in your facility.
