ATTACHMENT A

Special Conditions and Instructions

1. All shoulder areas shall be rolled and stabilized.
2. All non-paved and non-shoulder areas shall be seeded and mulched.
3. All shoulder areas shall be fine graded to ensure proper drainage away from road.
4. All dirt windrows shall be leveled and rolled to provide proper drainage.
5. All traffic control shall be in accordance with PA DOT Publication 213.
6. All roadways shall be swept clean after each working day.
7. Any noticed subsidence of shoulders shall be corrected immediately.
8. The permittee is responsible for maintaining all disturbed areas until they are stabilized with grass or stone, or accepted by the Luzerne County Road and Bridge Department.
9. All drainage swales shall be constructed back to original condition.
10. All driveways shall be replaced in kind and to the satisfaction of the property owner.
11. The owner of the facility is responsible for notifying the Luzerne County Road and Bridge Department upon completion of the project.
12. Refer to the detail enclosed for minimum accepted standards of work. The contractor shall construct the temporary and permanent pavement structure in accordance with Resolution No. 00RB01.
13. After "Request for Inspection" from the owner of the facility, all corrections to be made to the project before acceptance shall be in writing to the owner of the facility within two (2) days.
14. The permittee shall maintain the temporary pavement until the permanent restoration is completed or accepted by the Luzerne County Road & Bridge Department.
15. The permittee shall maintain all detour routes in accordance with item number 5 above and coordinate with local emergency services, agencies and local businesses.
16. All work shall be in accordance with the approved plans and PA PUC.
