It's the raw security camera footage prior to what was shown to us in Executive session. What we viewed during the Executive session was Part 2 and there is a Part 3 from the end of what we viewed to the paramedics working on Mr Mackey. Contained on the memory stick were also reports from the COs. Everyone should read the reports as well. The raw security camera footage (Part 1) requires video client software. That software is on the memory stick. That software has to be opened first, then the camera footage file. One can zoom in on the cell extraction. It will leave you thinking as to why the plaintiffs are requesting the maximum amount of insurance.

I had the opportunity to look on Facebook and YouTube. Pictures are out there and some were recently posted.

All of this has left me with more questions for County Management and with the same feeling of becoming a epicenter of civil unrest.
