

Dear Mr. Lawton,

I am writing you this document as a proposal to provide early intervention services to the Luzerne/Wyoming County MH/MR system from 7/1/2014 to 12/31/2014.

**Project Description**

Support Services for Infants and Toddlers, P.C. is an agency that solely provides early intervention services to families and children aged 0-2. These services are speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy and special needs instruction. The only service (for the Luzerne/Wyoming counties joinder) that we intend to provide in the years 2014-15 is early intervention.

**Description of Target Population**

As aforementioned, we serve families and their children who are aged birth through 2 years 11 months (until a day before their third birthday) as per state/federal regulations for Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Act. To qualify for the program, the child must have a delay of 25% or greater in one area of development or have a specific diagnosis recognized by the state.

**Statement of Need**

It is generally recognized that early intervention is a program which is growing in many areas of the nation. In Pennsylvania, counties and county joinders continue to exhibit a need for early intervention services in all disciplines. Our agency provides all four types of common interventions: speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy and special needs instruction. I am a speech/language pathologist, who has served your joinder since 1991. With regard to the families who we serve, it is our expertise in our specific areas of discipline that helps fulfill the families' needs when they need guidance in helping their children overcome their delays.

**Project Outcomes**

One outcome for our agency is to serve families and children with quality services that aid the families in helping their children develop in their areas of delay. This assists in helping them achieve the IFSP outcome(s) which they have identified with their service co-ordinator as well as other members of the IFSP team. Another outcome is to provide these services within the natural routines of the family (when learning by the child and family best takes place) and in the child's natural environment (where learning by the child and family best takes place). It is also our outcome to provide the county joinder and its employees with knowledgeable professionals, who fit well within the early intervention service model, and who also are flexible and accommodating to the families and service coordinators.

## Potential for Success

The potential for successful completion of our outcomes is great. We are an agency that has grown over the years in our ability and understanding of the complex and demanding regulations that have been put in place by the state in the area of early intervention. Early intervention is a program which has the greatest effect in helping remove obstacles that children encounter, in that it starts when a child is young, and it has the ability to personally teach families strategies and techniques to help their child develop. I believe that we do an excellent job in assisting these families with our professionals' expertise.


## Experience with This Service/Proposed Population and Coordinating Community Resources and Qualifications of the Individuals Performing the Services

Support Services for Infants and Toddlers, P. C. (SSIT), has provided early intervention services to Luzerne and Wyoming counties since 7/1/04. Previously, I, Gerald Gostynski, had provided speech/language support services for the 0-2 Early Intervention program since 1991, both privately and through other agencies. The services SSIT will continue to provide are: speech/language therapy, occupational therapy, physical therapy, and special needs instruction. All of our staff are either licensed or qualified to provide early intervention services in the state of Pennsylvania. As of April 14, 2014, our Luzerne/Wyoming Counties' speech therapists are the following: Anne Zaborny, who has been ASHA and PA licensed since 1986, and me (aforementioned). Our occupational therapist is Theresa Gushaulis, who has been licensed as an OT since 1989 and who has served EI since 2005. We currently do not have a physical therapist on staff, but will pursue one in the near future. Our special instructors (early interventionists) serving this joinder are the following: Sue Ann Slavinski, Bachelor's Degree in Special Education/Early Childhood Education who started working in EI in 2010, but who is also serving as our EI coordinator/special educator in several other joinders; Marie Challenger, who holds a Bachelor's Degree, speaks Spanish fluently, and has attained the credits necessary to provide early intervention services, serving EI since 2009; Marilyn Bolus, who holds a Special Education Master's Degree and who has served July 2011, but she had previously worked in EI at times over the past 25 years and Karen Hansler, who specializes in vision support for our families and children, has work in that domain for over 25 years. Our professionals and support staff in our agency have helped our families access a number of community resources through various avenues including the service co-ordination unit of the joinder, a number of assistance resources such as medical and financial assistance, programs and places for these families to let their children interact with other peers and a wealth of information related to the children's delay through materials, handouts, the internet, etc. Copies of all licenses/qualification documentation are attached.

## Budget

Since we only provide fee-for-service EI services for this county joinder at this time, we do not need to complete a budget summary. Our allotted county base budget for FY 2013/14 was \$120,000. We accept and use the state's set rates of \$27.99/unit for Special Needs Instruction (we use this rate for our vision special needs instruction also) and \$31.76 for each of the therapies (speech, occupational and physical). I also understand that the total reimbursement SSIT receives is actually based on the authorized amount and actual service provided and not an identified dollar amount in this contract. SSIT is a professional corporation whose president, 100% shareholder and director is Gerald J. Gostynski, Jr., president/speech therapist. Our agency's liability insurance is current and reflects the counties and state as co-insured.
