Thank you for writing to Luzerne County with your request for information pursuant to the Pennsylvania Right-To-Know law.

On January 23, 2014, we received from you a request for documents, namely, various environmental records related to a property on Country Club Road in Dallas, Pa. Your request for information via Right to Know request is denied for the following reason pursuant to the Right to Know Law ("RTKL").

Your request is denied per section 705 of the RTKL. Section 705 states "when responding to a request for access, an agency shall not be required to create a record which does not currently exist or to compile, maintain, format or organize a record in a manner in which the agency does not currently compile, maintain, format or organize the record."

Luzerne County does not maintain the records you requested for individual properties. We would suggest that you contact the local municipality or the Pennsylvania DEP in the event that they maintain the records you requested.

You have a right to appeal this response to your request for information in writing to Terry Mutchler, Executive Director, Office of Open Records, Commonwealth Keystone Building, 400 North Street, 4th Floor, Harrisburg, PA 17120.

If you choose to file an appeal you must do so within 15 business days of the mailing date of the agency's response. Section 1101.
