Charter reads as follows:

To make or cause to be made such studies, audits, and investigations applicable to County government as it determines are in the best interests of the County, compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents and other evidence deemed necessary, and to administer oaths and issue subpoenas signed by officers of County Council. County Council shall also have the power to define and punish any contempt relating to the enforcement of subpoenas consistent with laws applicable to counties of Luzerne County's classification functioning without a home rule charter or, in the absence of such laws, by state laws applicable to counties having populations closest to that of Luzerne County.

I certainly appreciate Mr. McGinley's concern however I don't believe he has jurisdiction to instruct the committee chairman of the duties of the committee that is clearly outlined by the charter.

The committee is supposed to do an inquiry that is in the best interest of the county. If that inquiry entails looking at day-to-day in an effort to streamline the process of that department that would be in the best interest of the county.

If the inquiry looks at the board of elections and its ability to performance functions as prescribed understate law or our charter that's the whole purpose of the inquiry.

I certainly understand Elections Bureau is busy trying to conduct an Election and I am sure that we would do nothing to hinder that operation.

I certainly think that the duty of this inquiry committee is to look at this department in us entirety to be sure that it is operating as efficiently as possible.
