ORDINANCE**

***An Ordinance of the County of Luzerne Amending Ordinance
No. 2021-05 Regarding the Administration of the Emergency
Rental Assistance Program***

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.07 of the Home Rule Charter of Luzerne County, County Council adopted the 2021 Fiscal Year Budgets which accounted for anticipated revenue and expenses; and

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2021, County Council enacted Ordinance No. 2021-05 pertaining to a Budget Amendment for Emergency Rental Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County was awarded funding from the U.S. Department of the Treasury to provide Rental Assistance in response to the Coronavirus pandemic; and

WHEREAS, County Council desires to amend the Budget at the appropriate line items in order to account for receipt and expenditure of funds from various sources related to Emergency Rental Assistance as follows:

Revenue:

Add 560.30.4653.470.80 Emergency Rental Income
Delete 560.30.4653.440.18 Housing Urban Development

Expenditures:

Add 560.30.4653.599.80 Emergency Rental
Delete 560.30.4653.599.50 Covid-19

NOW, THEREFORE, the following is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Luzerne County Council:

SECTION ONE. Incorporation of Preamble.

The provisions set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance are incorporated herein by reference in their entirety.

SECTION TWO. Amendment of Line Items in Ordinance 2021-05.

A public hearing having been held on February 23, 2021, County Council hereby amends the following line items in the Ordinance 2021-05 in order to properly account for receipt of funds from various sources related to Emergency Rental Assistance:

UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY FUNDING SOURCE:

Revenue:

Add 560.30.4653.470.80 Emergency Rental Income
Delete 560.30.4653.440.18 Housing Urban Development

Expenditures:

Add 560.30.4653.599.80 Emergency Rental
Delete 560.30.4653.599.50 Covid-19

SECTION THREE. Remainder of Budget.

All other line items in the 2021 Fiscal Year County Budget shall remain unchanged.

SECTION FOUR. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after enactment.




