Please let me know if any of the above-mentioned correction is possible. If so, please provide instructions on how to proceed, documentation needed and the fee.

Also, should it be possible we'd need to retrieve a certified copy of the records (amended, if possible). Please note that the Italian Consulate requires a **marriage record, complete with marriage license, marriage application and marriage certificate** (if possible).

If you can locate any record or if correction of any item above is possible, could you please provide the **fee** to retrieve all the above-mentioned records, and instructions on how to request a **certified copy** of them?

Dear Ms. Garbin,

I am the Open Records Officer and I process requests under the Right to Know law. I reached out to our Recorder of Deeds regarding your request, as it is part of public documents that are available, and thus, do not fall under the right to know law. Her name is Mary Dysleski and she forwarded the following information to assist you:

Our office provides certified marriage licenses for \$25.00 each. If there is an error in spelling on the application on record, that can only be corrected through Court Order. A Petition would need to be filed with the Clerk of Orphans' Court (our office) asking the court to make the corrections. There are no forms for this. It is a legal document. The filing fee is \$100.25 made payable to Register of Wills. Once our office receives an Order from the court making the corrections, the filer can request a certified copy of the license.

I hope this helps. If they need anything additional they can call our office at 570-825-1672
