

**RESOLUTION R-2021-83
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

*A Resolution of the Luzerne County Council Authorizing the County Manager to
Execute a Land Lease Amendment between Luzerne County and the
Borough of Freeland Municipal Authority for a 9-1-1 Tower Site in Foster Township*

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council has authority to approve of all leases concerning real property; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County entered into a Land Lease Agreement with the Borough of Freeland Municipal Authority on November 13, 2000 for a parcel of property located in Foster Township; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County 9-1-1 had utilized, and continues to utilize, this parcel for a communications tower site; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County 9-1-1 desires to amend the original Land Lease Agreement in order to erect a new tower and install a new shelter at the existing site to further the P-25 digital radio project; and

WHEREAS, the approval of the Land Lease Amendment will ensure continuing 9-1-1 operations in Luzerne County, thereby protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council desires to authorize the County Manager to execute the Land Lease Amendment.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Council authorizes the County Manager to execute a Land Lease Amendment with the Borough of Freeland Municipal Authority for the expansion of an existing 9-1-1 tower site located in Foster Township.


