ORDINANCE**

***An Ordinance of the County of Luzerne Amending
the 2021 Fiscal Year Budget for Luzerne County***

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.07 of the Home Rule Charter of Luzerne County, County Council adopted the 2021 Fiscal Year Budgets which accounted for anticipated revenue and expenses; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.10.F. of the Home Rule Charter states County Council may amend any of the budgets at any time during the fiscal year by ordinance adopted by an affirmative vote of at least a majority plus one of its current members after a public hearing has been held; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County was awarded funding from the Pennsylvania Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs to expand the Prevention services

WHEREAS, County Council desires to amend the Budget at the appropriate line items in order to account for receipt and expenditure of funds from the Pennsylvania Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs related to Prevention services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the following is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Luzerne County Council:

SECTION ONE. Incorporation of Preamble.

The provisions set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance are incorporated herein by reference in their entirety.

SECTION TWO. Amendment of Line Items in Budget.

A public hearing having been held on June 22, 2021, County council hereby amends the following line items in the 2021 Fiscal Year Budget in order to account for receipt of funds from the Pennsylvania Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs related to Housing and Housing-Focused Case Management.

DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES FUNDING SOURCE:

REVENUES:

Add Additional Fund Line in the Drug and Alcohol Budget – (Opioid Grant SOR – Prevention) with a budget of \$ 20,168.00.

EXPENDITURES:

Drug and Alcohol Line Item 960.70.9600.560.58 Provider Services shall be increased by \$ 20,168.00.

SECTION THREE. Remainder of Budget.

All other line items in the 2021 Fiscal Year County Budget shall remain unchanged.

SECTION FOUR. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after enactment.


