The survey asks about areas that are important to all people; such as community living, employment and health. As you know, SCs play a critical role in supporting people's needs. SCs plan with you (and your family member); find, arrange and monitor services; and guide the Individual Support Plan team.

Your feedback and the survey results will guide ODP's activity to achieve the highest satisfaction. The survey is anonymous and takes 10 minutes to complete. We encourage you and any family members to complete the survey, which will help ODP strive to support individuals with disabilities to live their best lives.
