

**RESOLUTION R-2021-122
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

A Resolution by the Luzerne County Council Ratifying the Declaration of Disaster Emergency for the Period of September 1 to September 5, 2021 that was Executed by the Acting Luzerne County Manager on September 1, 2021 in Response to Hurricane Ida and its Impacts on Luzerne County

WHEREAS, Hurricane Ida brought excessive rainfall to Luzerne County causing power outages, road closures, tree damage, flash flooding and evacuations to several areas; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County could potentially qualify for Federal Reimbursement for damages caused by Hurricane Ida; and

WHEREAS, on or about September 1, 2021, the Acting Luzerne County Manager ordered a Declaration of Disaster Emergency pursuant to powers granted to her by Section 4.07.B.6 of the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Acting County Manager's Declaration of Disaster Emergency needs to be ratified by County Council in order to potentially qualify for Federal Reimbursement.



ADOPTED at a meeting of the Luzerne County Council held on September 14, 2021.


