ORDINANCE

*An Ordinance of the County of Luzerne Adopting
the 2022 Fiscal Year Budgets for Luzerne County*

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.07 of the Home Rule Charter of Luzerne County, County Council desires to adopt the 2022 Fiscal Year Budgets as set forth in this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budgets do not cause the total budgeted expenditures and other uses in the budget to exceed the total of budgeted revenues and other sources of income plus any unreserved fund balance expected to be used; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budgets do not reduce budgeted expenditures required by law, for debt service or to meet any estimated unpaid obligations.

NOW, THEREFORE, the following is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Luzerne County Council:

SECTION ONE. Incorporation of Preamble.

The provisions set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance are incorporated herein by reference in their entirety.

SECTION TWO. Taxes.

County Council hereby approves the tax levied on all real estate property for general and special County purpose, including the payment of interest and principal of the funded debt, to be 6.1696 mills.

SECTION THREE. Approval of Budget.

County Council hereby approves the attached 2022 Fiscal Year Budgets, as amended, which Budgets are incorporated herein by reference in its entirety.

SECTION FOUR. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2022.


SECTION FIVE. Repealer.


