

# REQUEST FOR BIDS/INVITATION FOR BIDS

## COUNTY OF LUZERNE WILKES-BARRE WYOMING VALLEY AIRPORT, WILKES-BARRE, PENNSYLVANIA REHABILITATE TAXIWAY A

Sealed bids will be received by the Owner, the **County of Luzerne, Wilkes-Barre, PA**, via the PennBid Program until 3:00 p.m. local time, on **February 10, 2022**. Immediately thereafter, will be opened via the PennBid system and bid results will be available online at <http://PennBid.ProcureWare.com>. Contract will be awarded by the County.

In general, the improvements on which bids are requested will require the following major construction items:

- Site preparation/mobilization
- Place, Maintain and Move/Remove Safety Measures: Type I & II Barricades and BMPs
- Install Temporary Turf Taxiway
- Reclaim Existing Asphalt Pavement Along Taxiway A
- Widen Taxiway A from Existing 30' to 35' Width
- Overlay Pavement Along Taxiway A
- Mark and Stripe Entire Taxiway A
- Seeding
- Clean Work Areas

A non-refundable deposit of \$150.00 is required for a hard copy of the plans and bid documents. All Bidding Documents are available electronically at no cost at <http://PennBid.ProcureWare.com>

Contractors bidding need not be pre-qualified but shall be qualified to do the work.

All proposals submitted in accordance with the instructions presented herein will be subject to evaluation. Bids may be held by the **County of Luzerne** for a period not to exceed **one-hundred twenty (120) calendar days** from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

Award of contract will be based on the lowest aggregate sum proposal for the **TOTAL BASE BID OR TOTAL BASE BID, INCLUDING ADDITIVE** submitted from those bidders that are confirmed as being responsive and responsible. **Contractor's bidding shall bid all items**. The right is reserved, as the **County of Luzerne**, to reject any and all bids and to waive any or all irregularities, technicalities, informality or any information in the bids received.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid guaranty in the amount of not less than ten (10) percent of the total amount of the **TOTAL BASE BID**. The bid guaranty may be by certified check on a solvent bank or bid bond made payable to the **County of Luzerne**.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish separate performance and payment bonds, each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract. DBE participation is 1.29%.

Award of contract is also subject to the following provisions:

- 1) Executive Order 11246 and DOL Regulation 41 CFR PART 60 - Affirmative Action to Ensure Equal Employment Opportunity.
- 2) New Employee Work Eligibility Status authorized by the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996, 8 U.S.C. 1324a, known as the E-Verify Program.
