- Artwork must be 8½" x 11". Larger or smaller work will be disqualified.
- First and last name of student and name of student's agency or school must be included on the back of the poster.

Entries must be received at the Luzerne-Wyoming Counties MH/DS office by the close of business on Thursday April 28, 2022.
