

**RESOLUTION R-2022-75
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

***A Resolution of the Luzerne County Council Approving Demolition of
Building 16 (Franklin Dormitory) of the Keystone Job Corps Center***

WHEREAS, the Home Rule Charter, Section 2.09(B)(6), Powers and Duties, requires Luzerne County Council to approve by Resolution adopted by affirmative vote of at least a majority of its current members, agreements to acquire, lease, sell convey, vacate, or abandon land, buildings, or other real property; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America (“Government”), acting by and through the U.S. Department of Labor, leases the Keystone Job Corps Center from Luzerne County by Lease Dated August 8, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Paragraph 4(b) of the General Provisions of the Lease states “The Government may, at its own cost and expense, make such alterations, improvements or renovations to the Premises as the Government deems necessary for its use”; and

WHEREAS, the Government seeks to demolish Building 16 – Franklin Dormitory as the building is vacant and no longer needed for the Job Corps Center Program; and

WHEREAS, the Government seeks written approval from Luzerne County for the demolition in order to proceed on the project without delay; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Council approves the demolition of Building 16 of the Keystone Job Corps Center.

This Resolution shall become effective six days after adoption.




