A Resolution by the Luzerne County Council Requesting a Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant from the Pennsylvania Commonwealth Financing Authority

WHEREAS, Luzerne County hereby requests a Multimodal Transportation Fund grant of \$1,950,000 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for the construction of bike lanes and roadway improvements to Ransom Road, located in Dallas and Franklin Townships.

WHEREAS, the Applicant does hereby designate Romilda P. Crocamo Esq., Acting County Manager as the official to execute all documents and agreements between Luzerne County and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Council does approve the request of the submission.

This resolution shall become effective six days after adoption.




