A Resolution of the Luzerne County Council to Authorizing the County Manager to Execute Lease Documents for District Attorney Auto Theft Task Force Vehicle

WHEREAS, the Luzerne County District Attorney's Office is a member of the Pennsylvania Auto Theft Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Auto Theft Task Force ("Task Force") provides funding for counties to lease vehicles for Task Force duties; and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney's Office desires to lease a 2021 Ford Explorer for Task Force use utilizing Task Force funds with no contribution of funds from the County; and

WHEREAS, as a formality, the leasing company requires the governing body of Luzerne County to adopt a resolution authorizing the County Manager to execute the lease documents; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council desires to authorize the County Manager to execute any necessary documents required by the leasing company for the Task Force vehicle to be utilized by the District Attorney's Office.




