

**RESOLUTION R-2022-128
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

*A Resolution of Luzerne County Council Approving the Dedication for Public Use the Portion of
County Road 38, also Known as Mountain Drive, to the Township of Sugarloaf*

WHEREAS, the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter section 2.09.B.6. gives County Council the power to approve, by resolution adopted by affirmative vote of at least a majority of its current members, agreements to acquire, lease, sell, convey, vacate, or abandon land, buildings, or other real property; and

WHEREAS, previously the Luzerne County Administrative Branch proposed to Sugarloaf Township officials the repair and subsequent dedication for public use the portions of Luzerne County Road 38, also known as Mountain Drive, located within the Township of Sugarloaf (also referred to herein as "Township"); and

WHEREAS, repairs to Luzerne County Road 38 in the Township of Sugarloaf have been completed by Luzerne County to the satisfaction of Township officials and the Township is willing to accept the dedication of same; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council believes it is in the best interest of Luzerne County to dedicate for public use the portion of Luzerne County Road 38 located within the Township of Sugarloaf to the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by County Council for the County of Luzerne, Luzerne County hereby dedicates for public use the portion of Luzerne County Road 38, also known as Mountain Drive, located within the Township of Sugarloaf to the Township of Sugarloaf.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Manager shall have the authority to execute any and all documentation necessary for the transfer of ownership of County Road 38, located within the Township of Sugarloaf, to the Township of Sugarloaf.

This Resolution shall become effective 6 days after adoption.
