

**RESOLUTION R-2022-152
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

***A Resolution by Luzerne County Council Authorizing the County Manager to Execute
a Lease Agreement Between Luzerne County and Luzerne County Domestic Relations***

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Domestic Relations, a branch of the Luzerne County Court System, currently leases space located within 113 West North Street, Wilkes-Barre, also known as the Bernard C. Brominski building; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Domestic Relations provides services to Luzerne County residents related to the collection of child and spousal support payments; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County is desirous of entering into an additional 1-year lease with Luzerne County Domestic Relations in the annual amount of Two Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Nineteen Dollars (\$248,019.00), payable in equal monthly installments, for the continued rental of space in the Bernard C. Brominski building as specified in the lease agreement and subject to the terms and conditions contained therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Council authorizes the County Manager to execute a lease agreement between Luzerne County and Luzerne County Domestic Relations for office space in the Bernard C. Brominski Building subject to the terms and conditions contained in the Lease Agreement which is incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.


This resolution shall become effective six days after adoption.
