

**RESOLUTION R-2022-154  
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

***A Resolution by Luzerne County Council Declaring its  
Intent to Form a Luzerne County Manager Search Committee***

WHEREAS, Section 4.02 of the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter (the "Charter") sets forth the provisions for the selection of a full-time County Manager including, but not limited to, the requirement of County Council to form a Manager Search Committee (the "Committee") with members to be appointed by resolution of County Council adopted by an affirmative vote of at least a majority of its current members; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council held an executive session on November 9, 2022 and based on those discussions Luzerne County Manager Randy Robertson announced his intent to resign as County Manager; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council desires to declare its intent to form a County Manager Search Committee and immediately accept letters of interest from citizens of Luzerne County interested in serving on the Manager Search Committee subject to terms and deadlines to be set forth by Luzerne County Council.

BE IT RESOLVED, Luzerne County Council formally establishes a Luzerne County Manager Search Committee to be made up of three (3) Luzerne County citizens which shall be further subject to further terms and deadlines to be determined at the sole discretion of Luzerne County Council pursuant to the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter and any applicable state or federal laws.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
