

**RESOLUTION R-2022-155
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

***A Resolution of the Luzerne County Council Accepting the Resignation of
Luzerne County Manager and Appointing an Acting County Manager***

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2022, Randy Robertson announced his resignation as Luzerne County Manager with an effective date of December 14, 2022; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4.06 of the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter, Luzerne County Council may appoint an Acting County Manager by Resolution adopted by a majority vote of its current members; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council desires to accept the resignation of Randy Robertson as Luzerne County Manager to be effective at the close of business on Friday November 18, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council desires to also desires to appoint an Acting County Manager pursuant to Section 4.06 of the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Luzerne County Council accepts Mr. Robertson's resignation to be effective at the close of business Friday November 18, 2022 and Mr. Robertson shall be entitled to compensation for salary through December 14, 2022, as well as, compensation for unused vacation and sick leave pursuant to the terms of the Offer Letter that was agreed to and executed by County Council and the County Manager.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Luzerne County Council hereby appoints Brian Swetz as Acting County Manager at the annual rate of \$157,000.00 effective close of business November 18, 2022 and continuing until a permanent County Manager begins employment or Council adopts a Resolution changing this designation pursuant to Section 4.02 of the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

ADOPTED at a meeting of Luzerne County Council held on November 17, 2022.


