

# Official Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters County of Luzerne

January 31, 2023 Special Election

This is an official notice of a Special Election to be conducted on 01/31/2023 in Luzerne County. This Special Election is for Senator in the General Assembly for the 27th District of Pennsylvania. This district is comprised of the following precincts: Black Creek Township, Butler Township District 1, Butler Township District 02, Butler Township District 03, Butler Township District 04, Butler Township District 05, Conyngham Boro, Conyngham Township, Dorrance Township, Fairview Township District 01, Fairview Township District 02, Hollenback Township, Huntington Township, Nescopeck Boro, Nescopeck Township, New Columbus Boro, Nuangola Boro, Rice Township District 01, Rice Township District 02, Salem Township District 01, Salem Township District 02, Shickshinny Boro, Slocum Township, Sugarloaf Township District 01, Sugarloaf Township District 02, Sugarloaf Township District 03, Wright Township District 01, Wright Township District 02, Wright Township District 03, and Wright Township District 04.

You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at [www.vote.pa.gov](http://www.vote.pa.gov) or [www.fvap.gov](http://www.fvap.gov). You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to (570) 820-6399, or by email to [elections@luzernecounty.org](mailto:elections@luzernecounty.org).

You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB). Military electors may also use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

You may use the FWAB to vote for **all** federal, state, and local offices, and ballot initiatives.

To vote, fill out and send in the **Voter Information Page** (page 2) and **Official Backup Ballot** (page 3) of the FWAB.

To vote for offices or for ballot initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the appropriate section of the FWAB. Under the **Federal Offices** heading, enter the name or political party of the federal candidate you choose. Under the **Other Offices** heading, enter the state or local office, name of candidate or political party of the candidate you choose. Under the **Ballot Initiative or other items** heading, enter the title of the ballot initiative (referendum) you are voting on and write "yes" or "no."
