

**RESOLUTION R-2023-10
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

*A Resolution by Luzerne County Council Approving the Collective Bargaining Agreement
Between Luzerne County and Teamsters Local Union No. 401*

WHEREAS, certain attorneys within the Luzerne County District Attorney's Office and Public Defender's Office are unionized and employed subject to the terms of a collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, the most recent collective bargaining agreement covering these employees expired December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, County administration and the aforesaid employees, through their labor representatives, have negotiated in good faith a new collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.09 B.7 of the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter provides that County Council shall have the power to approve, by resolution adopted by affirmative vote of at least a majority of current Council members, collective bargaining agreements involving the County and its employees; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council desires to approve the collective bargaining agreement covering the aforesaid Teamsters Local Union 401 represented attorney employees within the Luzerne County District Attorney and Public Defender's offices for the period of January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Luzerne County Council hereby approves the collective bargaining agreement covering the aforesaid Teamsters Local Union 401 represented attorney employees within the Luzerne County District Attorney and Public Defender's offices for the period of January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2026.

This resolution shall become effective six days after adoption.
