

**RESOLUTION R-2015-122
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

A Resolution Seeking to Intervene in the Application of PennEast Pipeline Company, LLC for Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity and Related Authorization

WHEREAS, PennEast Pipeline Company, LLC, has filed a formal application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Committee regarding the construction and use of a pipeline; and

WHEREAS, PennEast Pipeline Company, LLC proposes to place a portion of this pipeline over the lands of County of Luzerne; and

WHEREAS, The County of Luzerne has concerns that such a pipeline could hinder the health, safety and welfare of its citizens as well deter the use and enjoyment of County lands; and

WHEREAS, The County Manager has recommended the initiation of litigation under Section 4.07 B3 of the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter in the form of a Motion to Intervene in matter CP15-558-000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Council approves the initiation of litigation and seeks the County Office of Law to file a Motion to Intervene in matter CP15-558-000 by October 29, 2015.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.




