ORDINANCE**

***An Ordinance of Luzerne County Council Amending the 2023 Fiscal Year Budget
In Order To Deposit \$109,601.98 into the Reserve Fund***

WHEREAS, Luzerne County held a special election for the Pennsylvania State House of Representatives 116th District on April 5, 2022 (the “Special Election”); and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania reimbursed Luzerne County \$109,601.98 for general funds paid by Luzerne County to conduct the Special Election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.07 of the Home Rule Charter of Luzerne County, County Council adopted the 2023 Fiscal Year Budget which accounted for anticipated revenue and expenses; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.10.F. of the Home Rule Charter states County Council may amend any of the budgets at any time during the fiscal year by ordinance adopted by an affirmative vote of at least a majority plus one of its current members after a public hearing has been held; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council desires to amend the 2023 fiscal year budget at the appropriate line items in order to deposit the \$109,601.98 reimbursement received from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania into the Reserve Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, the following is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Luzerne County Council:

SECTION ONE. Incorporation of Preamble.

The provisions set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance are incorporated herein by reference in their entirety.

SECTION TWO. Amendment of Line Items in Budget.

A public hearing having been held on April 11, 2023,
County Council hereby amends the following line item in the 2023 fiscal year budget in order to deposit the \$109,601.98 reimbursement received from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania into the Reserve Fund.:

- A. Increase of \$109,601.98 at line item 100.99.4940.445.10
- B. Increase of \$109,601.98 at line item 100.99.4940.585.10

SECTION THREE. Remainder of Budget.

All other line items in the 2023 Fiscal Year Luzerne County Budget shall remain unchanged.

SECTION FOUR. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after enactment.

ADOPTED by Luzerne County Council at a meeting held on April 11, 2023.


