

In order to be eligible to receive a lifetime dog license, the dog must be microchipped

Lifetime Dog License Application- Please fill out the owners and dogs information in its entirety and owners signature at the bottom of the page.

- A regular license status is for persons under the age of 65
- A senior license status is for persons over the age of 65. No proof of senior is required. Just provide us with your birthdate on the application.
- A disability license status requires you to provide a copy of your Social Security Disability of SSI award letter, social security disability card or a handicap placard.

Person with a disability is as follows:

"A person who received disability insurance or supplemental security income for the aged, blind, or disabled under the Social Security Act(49 Stat. 620, 42 U.S.C. Section 301 et seq.) or who has a handicapped plate under 75 PA.C.S. Section 1338 (relating to handicapped plate and placard)."

Permanent Identification Verification form – For Lifetime licenses, the State requires all dogs to be microchipped or tattooed.

- If you know your dog is microchipped and have zero contact with who implanted the microchip or don't know or remember, take your dog and these forms to the vet and ask them to please sign and fill out bottom portion of the Permanent Id Verification form provided your vet has previously scanned for the microchip and its documented in their records.
- Permanent Identification Verification Form (PIVF): The Permanent Identification Verification Form is to be completed and signed by the dog owner and the person scanning or implanting to microchip OR tattooing or verifying tattoo number. The dog owner fills out the top portion of the PIVF, and the veterinarian, veterinary technician or authorized shelter personnel fills out the bottom portion of the PIVF.
- • ****PLEASE NOTE**** There is no online option for submitting a Lifetime Dog License Application. The application may be submitted by in mail or in person.
