

**RESOLUTION R-2014-86
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

A Resolution by the Luzerne County Council Establishing the Intent of Moon Lake Park.

Whereas, Moon Lake Park has suffered rampant vandalism and theft due to lack of security from escalating budgetary cutbacks over these past several years; and

Whereas, a Master Plan was conceived in 2012 to help guide rehabilitation of the park and the financing thereof; and

Whereas, section 209.B.6 grants council the authority to make agreements on real property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Luzerne County Council establishes its will to pursue both security measures and infrastructure improvements as stated in section 1 of phase 1 of the 2012 Moon Lake master plan; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Luzerne County Council authorizes the County Manager to continue dialogue with state agencies to convey ownership and/or management; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Luzerne County Council Chair or his/her designee shall seek out private funding streams in order to restore Moon Lake to passive use should the park continue to be owned and/or managed by Luzerne County.

This resolution shall become effective six days from adoption.
