A Resolution by the Luzerne County Council Urging Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to Provide for Bicycle and Pedestrian Traffic in District 4-0.

WHEREAS Luzerne County Council wants to encourage safety, improve the quality of life and health of those living in Luzerne County, and encourage visitors to Luzerne County; and


WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council understands the interconnected relationships among economic development of Luzerne County, tourism, and a well-built environment that provides for multiple modes of transportation, healthy life styles, safety and recreation; and



WHEREAS, PennDot District 4-0 and their consultants design new roadways, highways, bridges and other components of our transportation systems and also design improvements and changes to existing roadways, highways, bridges and other components of our transportation systems;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Council requests and encourages that the staff and consultants of PennDot District 4-0 always provide for bicycle and pedestrian traffic when designing new roadways, highways, bridges and other transportation system components and when designing improvements to existing roadways, highways, bridges and other components of our transportation systems throughout Luzerne County; and to seek federal and state funding for such work.

This Resolution shall become effective six days after adoption.
