

**RESOLUTION R-2023-91
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

*A Resolution of Luzerne County Council Re-Allocating the Use of American Rescue Plan Act Funds
from Sweet Valley Road to Main Road*

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2022, Luzerne County Council passed Resolution R-2022-117 which authorized American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF) dollars, in the amount of \$1,860,000, to repair Sweet Valley Road in Ross and Union Townships; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County has spent \$30,844.32 on engineering to date for Sweet Valley Road; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County was allocated federal funding for improvements to Sweet Valley Road; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council would like to re-allocate the remaining available funds in the amount of \$1,829,155.68 to repair Main Road in Hunlock and Ross Townships; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County administration and Luzerne County Council believe it is in the best interest of the County to utilize American Rescue Plan Act Funds to repair Main Road in Hunlock and Ross Townships; and

WHEREAS, the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter at section 2.09.B.8, in part, requires Luzerne County Council to approve, by resolution adopted by affirmative vote of at least a majority of its current members, any contract or obligation that would result in a payment by the County of more than \$25,000 in any future calendar year for which no budget has been adopted; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Luzerne County Council approves the use and reallocation of American Rescue Plan Act funds in the amount of \$1,829,155.68 to repair Main Road in Hunlock and Ross Townships.

This Resolution shall become effective 6 days after adoption.
