

**RESOLUTION R-2023-118
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

***A Resolution by Luzerne County Council Approving the Collective Bargaining Agreement
Between Luzerne County and AFSCME, AFL-CIO, District Council 87 (Court Appointed
Support Staff Unit)***

WHEREAS, certain Court Appointed - Support Staff employees within the Division of Court Administration are unionized and employed subject to the terms of a collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, the most recent collective bargaining agreement covering these employees expired December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, County administration and the aforesaid employees, through their labor representatives, have negotiated in good faith a new collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.09 B.7 of the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter provides that County Council shall have the power to approve, by resolution adopted by affirmative vote of at least a majority of current Council members, collective bargaining agreements involving the County and its employees; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council desires to approve the collective bargaining agreement covering the aforesaid AFSCME, AFL-CIO, District Council 87 Court Appointed – Support Staff employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Luzerne County Council hereby approves the collective bargaining agreement covering the aforesaid AFSCME, AFL-CIO, District Council 87 Court Appointed – Support Staff employees subject to the terms and conditions contained therein.


This resolution shall become effective six days after adoption.
