

RESOLUTION R-2013-29
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL

*A Resolution by the Luzerne County Council Approving the Creation of a
County/Municipal Cooperative Agreement between Luzerne County and Forty Fort
Borough.*

WHEREAS, Section 2.09 B6 of the Home Rule Charter states that Luzerne County Council shall have the power to approve, by resolution adopted by affirmative vote of at least a majority of its current members, agreements to acquire, lease, sell, convey, vacate, or abandon land, buildings, or other real property.

WHEREAS, Forty Fort Borough has requested Luzerne County Council approval of the use of Luzerne County land for a compost site located by the Luzerne County Recreation Complex; and

WHEREAS, the land being requested for use is approximately one (1) acre or less located near the area in which top soil is currently stored; and

WHEREAS, the availability of a compost site would be beneficial to both Forty Fort Borough and Luzerne County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Council agrees to enter into a County/Municipal Cooperative Agreement with Forty Fort Borough to allow the use of land requested for the placement of a compost site.

This Resolution shall become effective on May 29, 2013.
