

**RESOLUTION R-2013-49
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

***A Resolution by the Luzerne County Council Approving the Recommended Thirteen
(13) Projects to be Funded by the Community Development Block Grant-Disaster
Recovery .***

WHEREAS, Congress and HUD allocated \$25.4 million in Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds to Luzerne County for disaster-related expenses as result of Hurricane Irene and Tropical Storm Lee; and

WHEREAS, the Luzerne County Office of Community Development received requests from municipalities for disaster related infrastructure projects requiring assistance which were reviewed by a committee in a multi-step process to fairly evaluate the requests and provide recommendations of projects to be funded; and

WHEREAS, thirteen (13) projects located in several municipalities throughout Luzerne County have been recommended to receive funding;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Council approves the recommended thirteen (13) projects be funded by the Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery funds totaling \$10,000,000.00 as follows:


1. Hunlock Twp: Roaring Brook Drive Rehabilitation	\$ 300,000.00
2. Luzerne County: Tunnel Road Rehabilitation	\$1,400,000.00
3. Luzerne County: Coxton Railroad Bridge Disposition	\$ 614,671.41
4. Nanticoke City: West Union Street Bridge Creek Bed Rehab.	\$ 205,350.00
5. Plymouth Twp: West Poplar Street Rehabilitation	\$ 112,000.00
6. Plymouth Twp: Jessie Road Rehabilitation	\$ 211,200.00
7. Plymouth Twp: Pavlick Hill Road Rehabilitation	\$ 211,200.00
8. Redevelopment Authority of Luzerne County: Building Repairs	\$ 134,020.00
9. Shickshinny: Drainage, Road, Curb & Sidewalks Rehabilitation	\$1,661,578.00
10. Shickshinny: Sewer Rehabilitation	\$1,138,419.00
11. West Pittston: Flood Inundation, Sewer and Road Rehabilitation	\$3,351,891.09
12. West Pittston: Ann Street Sewer & Drainage Rehabilitation	\$ 468,000.00
13. Wilkes-Barre City: Old River Road Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation	\$ 191,670.50
