

RESOLUTION R-2012-17
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL

A Resolution by the Luzerne County Council reappointing a member to the Farmland Preservation Board

WHEREAS, the effective date for the new form of Luzerne County government provided for in the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter (the "Charter") is Monday, January 2, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Section 8.02 (A) of the Charter provides that except as may otherwise be provided for in this Charter, the Administrative Code, or applicable law, all members of County boards and commissions shall be appointed by resolution of County Council adopted by an affirmative vote of at least a majority of its current members;

WHEREAS, Section 8.02(D) of the Charter provides that except as may otherwise be provided for in the Charter or applicable law, each member of any County board or commission shall serve until the expiration of his/her term and a new appointment is made;

WHEREAS, Fred "Ted" Dymond was a member of the Farmland Preservation Board, whose terms expired on December 31, 2011.

WHEREAS, the County Council wishes to reappoint a member to the Farmland Preservation Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the County Council wishes to reappoint Fred "Ted" Dymond to the Farmland Preservation Board, such appointment to remain effective until December 31, 2014, or until an appointment is declared vacant by County Council pursuant to Section 11.06 of the Charter.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
