A Resolution by the Luzerne County Council Appointing a County Council member to the Operation Gang Up Task Force

WHEREAS, the effective date for the new form of Luzerne County government provided for in the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter (the "Charter") is Monday, January 2, 2012; and

WHEREAS, *Operation Gang Up Task Force*, a partnership of experts from Luzerne and Lackawanna Counties, with the goal of educating students, parents, and the local community on gang awareness and anti-gang activities, requests that one seat on its Board of Directors be held by a representative of the Luzerne County governing body for a one year term.

WHEREAS, the County Council wishes to appoint a member of County Council, selected by resolution adopted by an affirmative vote of at least a majority of its current members, to the Operation Gang Up Task Force; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the County Council wishes to appoint *Edward Brominski*, a member of County Council, to the Operation Gang Up Task Force, such appointment to remain effective until the appointment is declared vacant by County Council pursuant to Section 11.06 of the Charter.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
