LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL

A Resolution by the Luzerne County Council to announce a Vacancy on the Luzerne County Drug and Alcohol Executive Committee

WHEREAS, the effective date for the new form of Luzerne County government provided for in the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter (hereinafter the "Charter") is Monday, January 2, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the By-Laws of the Luzerne County Drug and Alcohol Executive Committee have as its goal the eradication of addiction within the County and to provide the highest quality of service to chemically dependent county residents in matters of prevention, intervention and treatment and requires that a seat on its Board of Directors be held by a resident of Luzerne County; and

WHEREAS, Olga Pappa, a Luzerne County Drug and Alcohol Executive Committee member's term expired on March 17, 2012, which created a vacancy of a position per Section 11.06 of the Charter.

WHEREAS, Section 11.06 of the Charter provides that whenever facts or circumstances result in a vacancy as defined in this Charter or applicable law in any elective office or on any County authority, board, or commission, County Council at its next regularly scheduled or special meeting shall declare such office vacant by resolution adopted by an affirmative vote of at least a majority of its current members.

WHEREAS, County Council wishes to declare a vacancy on the Luzerne County Drug and Alcohol Executive Commission; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Council declares a vacancy on the Luzerne County Drug and Alcohol Executive Commission.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
