A RESOLUTION CLOSING OUT COMMUNITY CONSERVATION
PARTNERSHIPS GRANT PROJECT (BRC-TAG-14-218)

WHEREAS, the County of Luzerne has prepared a Master Site Development Plan and Pool Feasibility Study for Moon Lake Park; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Plan is to provide background information, site information and analysis, park facilities inventory, assessment of existing electrical, water and waste water systems, infrastructure inventory, design considerations, program identification, master plan, pool feasibility study, construction cost estimates and maintenance and operating costs and revenue to guide Luzerne County in making future decisions regarding Moon Lake Park; and,



- d. The Plan and related materials will be used to guide future recreation and conservation decisions.


