

**RESOLUTION R-2012-92
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

A Resolution by the Luzerne County Council Ratifying the Declaration of Disaster Emergency for the Period of October 29, 2012 to November 2, 2012 that was Executed by the Luzerne County Manager on October 29, 2012 in Response to Hurricane Sandy and its Impacts on Luzerne County.

WHEREAS, Hurricane Sandy brought high speed winds and rain fall to Luzerne County causing excessive power outages, road closures, and tree damage to several areas; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County could potentially qualify for Federal Reimbursement for damages caused by Hurricane Sandy; and

WHEREAS, on or about October 29, 2012, the Luzerne County Manager ordered a Declaration of Disaster Emergency pursuant to powers granted to him by Section 4.07B.6. of the Luzerne County Home Rule Charter (See Attached);


WHEREAS, the County Manager's Declaration of Disaster Emergency needs to be ratified by County Council in order to potentially qualify for Federal Reimbursement;
